The Secretary General greeted the members of the Council and invited the President to speak and present the President's report.

Prof. Arun Chougule made his report and informed the audience about the AFOMP's current and planned activities (Annexure-I).

The Vice President, Prof. Eva Bezak, then gave an update on recent activities and, as chair of the AHC, she described the award and honors committee's report (Annexure-II).

The Treasurer of the AFOMP outlined the year's income and expenditures in detail (Annexure-III). Prof. Kwan Ng, the Treasurer, suggested that 50% of the income be put into fixed deposits. Prof. Arun also intends to raise the AFOMP Fund to \$100,000 during his tenure at the AFOMP. In this situation, \$50,000 can be used as a corpus fund to keep the AFOMP activities sustainable.

National Member Organizations (NMOs) were also encouraged to donate to AFOMP, the parent organization, in the same way as KSMP did.

The chairs of the Education and Training Committee (ETC), Science Committee (SC), and Professional Relationship Committee (PRC) have detailed descriptions of their respective committees' activities (Annexure-IV).

Finally, SG presented her report and future activities (Annexure-V).

All of the reports have received unanimous approval.

Then, according to the agenda, SG, AFOMP requested that all allocated personnel submit their reports in order. The following is a detailed description of these:

AFOMP Newsletter report: Present by Dr V. Subramani, Editor

Dr. Subramani, editor of the AFOMP Newsletter, presented slides on the newsletter. He mentioned that there were regular newsletters published in January and June of each year, as well as special issues commemorating AFOMP's 20th anniversary. The newsletters include scholarly publications, CPD programs, webinars, AFOMP school programs, South Asia Centre for Medical Physics and Cancer Research (SCMPCR) programs, and other information.

In the future, he will request Dr. Tomas Kron to assist in obtaining PhD abstracts for inclusion in the AFOMP newsletter, and in future AFOMP would like to publish in an AFOMP journal. Council members are requested to submit articles, news, events for better visibility of NMOs.

Progress of AOCMP2022- Presentation by Ms. Ting-Chuan Alice Li

Vice-Chairman for the International and Public Relations Committee of CSMPT AOCMP 2022, on behalf of the Organizing Committee Ms Alice Li briefed the audience on the preparations for the upcoming AOCMP 2022, which will be held on December 10-12, 2022. She also presented the expected registration fees, airport connectivity, website information, committees, preliminary program, gala dinner, and welcoming reception, all of which are related to the AOCMP, using power point slides.

The deadline for abstract submission is March 1, 2022. The website address is www.aocmp2022.com.

The OC AOCMP 2022 was told by the AFOMP President to provide more discounted registration fees to overseas students. Ms Alice responded by saying that AOCMP 2022 would oversee the sponsorship amount at first, and later the fees would be reassessed. Dr. Chai also requested that participants be provided with lodging information, both high-end and low-end. In general, fees for registration and lodging must be considered for Middle and Lower Income Countries, particularly for the students, young researchers, and faculties.

AOCMP2023, ICMP 2023 and plans from AOCMP2023 organizers report: Presented by Dr S. D. Sharma, AMPI President

Dr. S. D. Sharma, on behalf of the ICMP 2023 Organizing Committee (8-11 December 2023), presented the slides that provide an overview of the host country Mumbai. Mumbai has all of the necessary infrastructure to host an international conference. Because AMPI is preoccupied with planning the 2021 Annual Conference in January, the OC will provide more information after that.

WC 2022 in Singapore: Presented by Dr. James Lee, Co-Chair Scientific Committee, WC 2022

Dr James Lee, speaking on behalf of the WC 2022 Organizing Committee (12-17 June 2022), stated that this is the first time the WC would host in Southeast Asia. It will be done in a hybrid style. Keynote speakers, plenary speakers, and special symposia have all been scheduled in the meantime. He was quite clear about the location, registration fees, and lodging, among other things. He also indicated that the registration fee would be half of the onsite participants for the online participants. He also encouraged members to visit the website for all pertinent information, noting that early bird registration will begin in November 2021. More than 200 abstracts have been submitted so far, with the OC expecting more.

Dr. Chai has inquired for a deadline extension in the conversation box. The deadline for abstract submission has been extended till January 14th, decided by OC.

IOMP has signed the MOU with AMPI, AFOMP, and SEFOMP for ICMP 2023 and there were seven legitimate bids to host WC 2028. No nominations from AFOMP have been submitted at this time because the WC 2022 (Singapore) and ICMP 2023 (Mumbai) and WC2025 (Adelaide) are already taking place in the AFOMP region. In Singapore next host for WC will be decided.

She also briefed the audience about the recipients of several categories IOMP awards.

IUPAP young Scientist award 2021 - A/Prof Chai Hong Yeong, Malaysia

IDMP winner from the AFOMP region: Prof Shigekazu Fukuda, Japan

FIOMP: Number of IOMP fellows has been awarded in this year: Prof Arun Chougule, Dr Freddy Haryanto, and Prof Golam Abu Zakaria

These awards will be officially presented in Singapore in 2022 at the World Congress.

AOCMP is one of the conferences that IOMP has endorsed. The conferences in India, Hong Kong, and Japan were also endorsed in 2021. The policy has been slightly changed for any endorsement application. Because the running costs of an online meeting are lower than that of a face-to-face meeting, only 40% of the original award value will be given if the congress is held entirely online. Hybrid gatherings will continue as long as the Covid crisis persists. Face-to-face meetings will begin shortly after the Covid crisis has ended.

Three journals of AFOMP (*Physical and Engineering Sciences in Medicine; ACPESM, Radiological Physics and Technology; Japan and Journal of Medical Physics; India*) have all been announced the official Journals of IOMP as well. Currently, ACPSEM and IOMP have signed a Memorandum of Understanding for the journal. IOMP also hosts 1-2 webinars/month, which run smoothly throughout the year. The next webinar will take place in mid-January. The first one is titled Re-igniting the role of physics in medicine, Wednesday, 19th January 2022 by Prof. Robert Jeraj.

It was also decided that once in every 3 months; IOMP will invite a PhD student or early career researchers to present a webinar on their research. This is an opportunity to present to a larger audience. NMOs suggestions are much appreciated.

In 2022, Prof. Eva is in charge of organizing 2-3 IOMP webinars. So any suggestions to Eva are very appreciated, particularly to transfer knowledge about the rapidly changing environment of technology.

The IOMP is now holding elections for new officers, chairs of different committees that will assume offices in Singapore in 2022, till October 2025. All regions submitted nominations and Nomination Committee is now working on them. The election will be held from 10 January to 11 February 2022.

Lastly All the AFOMP EXCOM and council members thanked to the team of AOCMP 2021 organizers for having a nice organized conference.






Thanks to Eva Bezak, Chair AHC and the members for the hard work in preparing the guidelines, application forms and assessing/evaluating the applications received very meticulously. This year's AFOMP Lifetime achievement awardee is Dr. Masahiro Endo, Japan
- 5. AFOMP has now three official journals AFOMP and decided to encourage the research article submission to the AFOMP official journal and decided to award one publication every year from the AFOMP official journal as best research publication, the awarded cash prize and certificate. The AFOMP journal best publication awardee for the 2021 is Yoshiro Ilko Japan

The following activities have been accomplished since the last report (October 201)):

- Due to the excellent efforts of AFOMP President, Prof Chougule, financial support was obtained from the Korean Society of Medical Physics, Parameswaran family and Krishnamurthy family to establish new AFOMP awards (TORs were also developed) as follows:
 - a) The C.V. Saraswathi -A.N. Parameswaran Memorial AFOMP best PhD award to be given for the best PhD thesis in Physical Sciences with relevance for medicine that has demonstrated excellent PhD research work in terms of clinical relevance, scientific merit and publications capacity.
 - b) The Professor Sung Sil Chu AFOMP Best Student's Publication Award is an annual award to be given to the best publication by MSc or PhD students in medical physics from a low- or lower-middle-income countries to encourage publications from students during their postgraduate studies. (TORs were developed with the help of A/Prof Yeong.)
 - c) PN Krishnamurthy Memorial AFOMP Young Achiever Award to support and encourage promising young medical physicists from the AFOMP region at an early stage in their career.

The AFOMP lifetime achievement award is presented to Prof Masahiro Endo from Japan, Executive Director of the Association for Nuclear Technology in Medicine, Japan for considerable contribution to medical physics profession and research in Japan and the AFOMP region.
- 5. **AFOMP Journal Prize for the Best Paper published in an AFOMP Journal** (Radiological Physics and Technology, Physical and Engineering Sciences in Medicine and Journal of Medical Physics) authored by an AFOMP member: 9 nominations were received (compared to 21 in 2020). The winner is Dr Ieko from Tohoku University and Yamagata University, Japan for his paper titled: The impact of 4DCT-ventilation imaging-guided proton therapy on stereotactic body radiotherapy for lung cancer, RPT (2020); vol.13:230–237. (Evaluated by the AFOMP Science Committee.)
- 6. **PN Krishnamurthy Memorial AFOMP Young achiever award:** 7 nominations have been received. The winner is Ying Song, West China Hospital, Sichuan, China who performed exceptionally, including contribution toward development of medical physics education and training at her institution and in China.
- 7. **The C.V. Saraswathi -A.N. Parameswaran Memorial AFOMP best PhD**: 8 nominations were received. The best Ph.D. awardee is Wonjoong Cheon from Proton Therapy Center, National Cancer Center, Gyeonggi-do, Republic of Korea; for thesis titled: Development of mechanical and dosimetric quality assurance system using cameras with artificial neural networks.
- 8. The Professor Sung Sil Chu AFOMP Best Student's Publication Award for a student from a low- or lower-middle-income country received 2 nominations.
