

# 22<sup>nd</sup> Asia-Oceania Congress of Medical Physics (AOCMP) 2022 10-12 December 2022, Taipei, Taiwan <u>www.aocmp2022.com</u>

Due to travel difficulties for Covid-19 this year in the upcoming AOCMP 2022 in Taiwan, AFOMP will not offer any travel award. It is decided to provide online/ in person [partial] registration fees up to10 delegates in the coming AOCMP 2022 instead of travel award.

#### **Goals of the Awards**

- 1. To assist medical physicists from LMIC countries in the AFOMP region to participate [in person or virtually] and present their work at the 22<sup>nd</sup> AOCMP.
- 2. To foster international co-operation in the field of medical physics between AFOMP member countries.

## The Awards

- 1 The AFOMP assistant for virtual delegates will be US\$ 80 and for in-person delegates US\$ 200.
- 2 For each category (virtual/in person) five awards will be declared (Total 10).

## Mandatory Requirements

- 1 The applicant shall be a medical physicist (including medical physics students) currently practicing in an AFOMP member country<sup>1</sup>; and
- 2 If an applicant is practicing in a country in which there is an AFOMP member organization, the applicant must be a member of that organization and the member organization must be up to date with its AFOMP subscription; and
- 3 The applications shall be verified and endorsed by the respective AFOMP member organizations (this condition may be exempted for applicants from countries where medical physics organizations do not exist); and
- 4 The applicant shall submit at least one abstract accepted for presentation at the 22<sup>nd</sup> AOCMP; and
- 5 The awardee shall register and attend the Congress virtually or in person
- 6 The awardee shall submit a short report by January 30, 2023 to the AFOMP Secretary-General and to the awardee's Medical Physics Association/Society on what was learnt at the Congress and how he/she intends to apply that in his/her own country.

## **Selection Criteria**

Higher priority will be given to the following.

- Applicants from developing countries/areas.
- Candidate whose abstract is accepted as oral presentation will only be considered.
- The value to the applicants in promoting medical physics in their institutions/countries in attending the congress. Applicants with higher quality abstracts
- Younger scientist will avail this award.

## Application Procedure

- 1. Applicants should complete the application form given below.
- Complete application form must be sent by email to: Dr Hasin Anupama Azhari, Secretary General at on or before
  1 November 2022 can apply.
- 3. Applications received shall be considered by the Professional Relations Committee [PRC], whose decision shall be final. Applicants should provide in their applications all relevant information for assessment by the Committee.
